Next year, your child will be asked to multiple large numbers, divide, compute common denominators, reduce fractions, etc. A strong knowledge of multiplication facts greatly increases their success in mastering these other mathematic concepts. The only way to master memorization of the multiplication facts is through repeated practice of the facts. Please spend time together memorizing the multiplication facts! *Multiplication fact cards can be purchased at Dollar Tree and other stores*.
