

Chicora town – part of St. Johns Berkeley Township (**E.D. 28**)

Holly Hill town – part of east St. James Goose Creek Township (**E.D. 22**)

Lincolnvile town - part of west St. James Goose Creek Township. Census data taken in 1890, 1900, & 1910, population statistics – 388, 400, 341 respectively. (**E.D. 23**)

Moncks Corner town, part of St. Johns Berkeley Township. Census data taken in 1890, 1900, & 1910, population statistics – 115, 202, 232 respectively. (**E. D. 30**)

Pecks town - part of east St. James Goose Creek Township (**E.D. 24**)

St. Dennis and St. Thomas Township - census data taken in 1890, 1900, & 1910, population statistics – 2,905, 2,737, 2,728 respectively. [**E.D. 16 (north part), 17 south part**)]

St. James Goose Creek Township – not a census district until 1910, population– 1,003 [**E.D. 19 & 20 (east parts)**], [**E.D. 21 (west part)**]

Second St. James Goose Creek Township, including Lincolnvile town - not a census district until 1910, population– 4,906 (**E.D. 23**)

St. James Santee Township - census data taken in 1890, 1900, & 1910, population statistics – 2,894, 1,286, 1,057 respectively. (**E.D. 25**)

St. Johns Berkeley Township, including Moncks Corner town - not a census district until 1910, the population – 3,660 (**E.D. 26, 27**)
